AI agents are moving from text generation into action: refunds, denials, case closure, deployments, customer messages, account changes, and operational commitments. Orange defines an independent legitimacy gate between proposed AI action and real-world consequence. It does not inspect private model reasoning; it governs whether an action may reach reality.

The system that accelerates action should not also monopolize the brake.

Agent may think. Agent may propose. Agent may not mutate reality without verified authority.

Constitutional Rules

A prompt is not authority.
A machine proposal is not authority.
Agent claim is not evidence.
UNKNOWN is not permission.
Deny before mutation.

Absence of observation is not observation of absence.
A system's future authority must not originate from the system itself.
Public architecture is not runtime proof.

What Orange Does

1. Gate AI-to-reality action	2. Produce a decision record	3. Preserve independent authority
Checks authority, evidence, risk, boundary, and current state before a proposed AI action reaches a customer, system of record, or external consequence.	A Release Log is an evidence-backed public record of bounded release. An Issue Card is a stop or escalation record when proof is missing, conflicted, or unresolved.	Orange separates action acceleration from release authority. The tool that moves fast should not also become the unchecked brake, judge, and witness.

First Wedge: AI Customer Support Actions

Concrete actions

Refund, reject refund, close case, escalate case, promise compensation, deny a paying customer, change account status, or send a binding customer message.

Before AI support agents refund, deny, close, escalate, or promise, Orange checks the evidence.

Why it matters

Faster action without independent authority creates faster institutional risk.

Audit after mutation = forensic visibility.
Deny before mutation = control.

Orange turns agent confidence into either an evidence-bound release decision or a visible issue.
